2) When expansion was introduced in 1967, six new teams were created, adding more players. What were the six new teams added, and how did expansion affect General Managers?

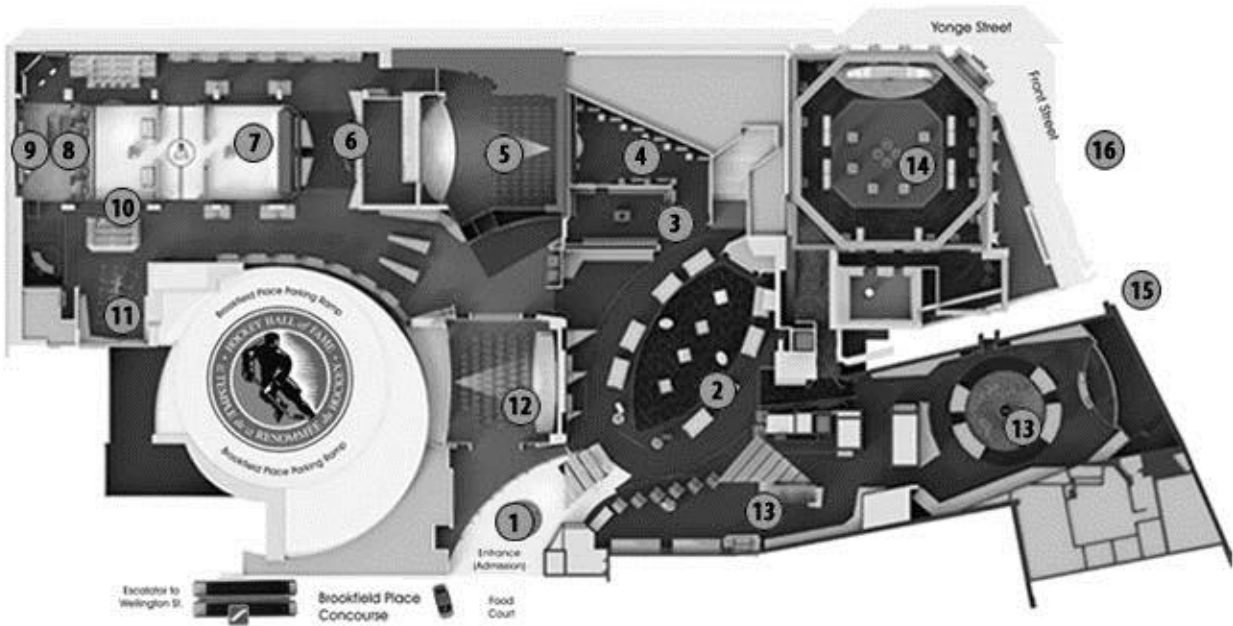
